IOSH Managing Safely Course

Managing Safely is for personnel who have to manage risk & resources. This allows candidates to apply basic management principles & practices to safety & health issues as part of a total management strategy.

Certification - On successful completion of a short answer test & a practical assessment in the workplace the delegate will receive an IOSH Accredited Certificate.

- **HSS7 Award**

(Make sure your own actions within the workplace aim to protect the environment)

HSS7 Award

This Course is aimed at any employee and is about maintaining good practice in the workplace by identifying activities that may be impacting on the environment and using resources efficiently, thereby minimising risk.

Certification – On successful completion of the award you will receive an OCR Accredited Certificate

- **HSS8 Award**

(Review health & safety procedures in workplaces)

HSS8 Award

This award is aimed at people who are assessing risk in workplaces other than their own, whether this be in another location/area within their own organisation or in another organisation altogether.

Certification – On successful completion of the award you will receive an OCR Accredited Certificate

We are also offering ½ day workshops to train and support staff who need to work towards the HSS8 award. This will ensure that staff who need to achieve the HSS8 award will have a comprehensive understanding of their role and responsibilities when completing workplace vetting.
